

Children of The Resurrection

Does resurrection happen after we have died? Is the body resurrected after death? What is death? Death is not what we think it is. The body is resurrected but there is a death that is different to the teaching we've received down through the ages and our current body is changed or resurrected. **It is the false consciousness that produces the false body that dies.** But wasn't Jesus' body resurrected after the crucifixion? Yes, it was, but his consciousness was already resurrected which is why this could happen and he could say this,

[Jhn 2:19 KJV] Jesus answered and said unto them, Destroy this temple (*body*), and in three days I will raise it up.

His consciousness was resurrected (raised up) from a human, mortal point of view to the immortal view, with a divine understanding and because of this his body was changed, raised up too. And so he "could lay down his life and take it again" (Jhn 10:17, 18).

It's our **consciousness** that is **resurrected (raised) while we are still living this life** and because of this our bodies "change" too. The mind and the body are the same thing.

[Phl 3:20, 21 KJV] For our conversation (*vibration*) is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ: **Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body**, according to the working (*of energy*) whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself.

We have believed that we were born biologically of our parents, with all the accumulated genetics and mannerisms of countless ancestors, but this is not the case, "we are not our own".

[1Co 6:19 KJV] What? know ye not that **your body is the temple** of the Holy Ghost [which is] in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?

[Psa 100:3 KJV] Know ye that the LORD he [is] **God: [it is] he [that] hath made us**, and **not we ourselves**; [we are] his people, and the sheep of his pasture.

For our consciousness to be resurrected in this present lifetime we must, at first, realise **we are already dead**. That's right we are already dead! We feel very much alive - walking, talking, eating, breathing, etc, but until "we hear the voice of the Son of God" we're all "dead in our sins", laying in our own graves. We have all heard the phrase of someone "digging a hole" for themselves, well that's what we've done, because we haven't heard or even had the "ears to hear", until now, the "voice of the Son of God".

[Jhn 5:25 KJV] Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the **dead** shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they **that hear shall live**.

We have been in **error** because of our **limited understanding** of how things work. Resurrection means a raising up. It is a raising up of our understanding, our consciousness which **in Truth comes first**, not our bodily form first. Being born into a world where everyone is in the same boat of understanding we just follow the crowd and get on with growing, learning, getting a job, marrying, having children, retiring, having grandchildren, getting old and decrepit and dying, or we "**perish**" as the Bible puts it, only to do it all again. And so it goes, on and on and Christmas is just a yearly commercial holiday to enjoy, including a brief nod to the Nativity as it's a nice little story from yesteryear... No wonder then that Jesus said, "**Follow me** and let the dead bury their dead" (Mat 8:22).

The Old Testament prophecies culminate in the New Testament, in the birth, sayings and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Which is all about raising our understanding to a new level so that we don't just continue to "perish" but **really** live instead.

When it says that we were "**dead** in our sins" and "uncircumcised in our flesh" we were that way because we, unknowingly, were **and still are** living as a body-person because of a lack of understanding. An "uncircumcised in the flesh" body-person is someone who lives an assumed life, believing that they are a body who is born, decays and dies. They live in a 'body-consciousness' not realising there is another way.

This assumed life and all that goes with it is sin (definition of sin - missing the mark). We are "missing the mark" through ignorance of the True man/woman, but HE has made us alive. We've been "made alive" **by his body**, by **his knowledge**. He, Jesus Christ, didn't miss the mark, he **hit** the mark. The 'mark' being the Body held in Mind, the Father's Mind always perfect in form and the activity of all the bodily organs - therefore eternally **alive**.

The "circumcision of Christ" is the cutting away, in each individual's understanding, of the "flesh" or body that consists of not only many false beliefs, but all the ancestral genes and mutations that accumulate over time.

[Col 2:11,13 KJV] In whom also **ye are circumcised** with the circumcision made without hands (*made in understanding*), in **putting off the body of the sins of the flesh** by the circumcision of Christ: And you, being **dead in your sins** and the **uncircumcision of your flesh**, hath he quickened together (**made alive**) **with him**, having **forgiven** you all trespasses;

When Lazarus (who had a body-consciousness like everyone else) had been in a tomb for four days and Martha (his sister) didn't believe that Jesus could do anything for her brother now that he had died, said this to her,

[Jhn 11:25 KJV] Jesus said unto her (*Martha*), **I am** the **resurrection**, and the **life**: he that believeth in me (*has my Consciousness*), though he were **dead**, yet shall he **live**:

And then of course he called Lazarus, who was very much dead (to our way of thinking of dead), to come out of the tomb which he then did!

Eventually everyone will have the resurrection of this false, collective body-consciousness, and the revelation of our True Identity.

[2Pe 3:9 NIV] The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to **perish**, but everyone to come to **repentance** (*turn from a back to front consciousness*).

How can this ongoing cycle of existence be? Until we **hear, really hear** and get off the hamster wheel of mortal life things carry on being upside down or back to front. They are back to front because instead of our bodies, environment, and experiences determining our thinking (our consciousness), as they do now, our thinking (our Consciousness) of the abundance of All-Good should determine our bodies, environment and experiences.

In the crucifixion Jesus Christ, because of his Consciousness, was able to allow his body to die and then resurrect three days later, as he had said it would. He did this to **show us** (the collective body-consciousness) that to "know HIM (his Consciousness) is life eternal" (Jhn 17:3).

The collective body-consciousness "judges from appearance" (Jhn 7:24), so the body and all it sees and feels, etc, comes first and the consciousness comes last, but the One Consciousness comes first in Truth. In the "repentance" way the One Consciousness comes first and the body last. The One Consciousness of the abundance of All-Good everywhere may sound, initially, too good to be true but, amazingly, it is true.

The bodies which we have medicated, bandaged, exercised, put on various diets, injected with Botox, and subjected to many other things to keep them well and to slow the ageing process are not what we've thought they were.

[Mat 6:25-26 KJV] Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat (*eating*), and the body than raiment (*clothes*)? Behold the fowls (*birds*) of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better (*of more value*) than they?

Vibration

We have been unaware that **consciousness is vibration**, and that when Jesus said, "hear the voice of the Son of God" he was talking about the "voice" being a frequency and the "hear" being to resonate with that voice; to resonate with the vibrations of that frequency, the Consciousness of All-Good. When we resonate with something we come into alignment with it. Like when tuning a guitar string - the vibrations of the individual string must resonate (sound the same) as the individual note sounding on the tuner. So we must sound the same, resonate with "Son of God". He is our tuner!

Consciousness, although seemingly **unseen** is actually **seen**. The vibrations of consciousness are slowed down to a point where they are experienced by the senses. Our body or what we see, feel, hear, taste and smell is our present consciousness and we judge by these experiences, causing our body-consciousness to come first.

We sense first, then we are conscious of that which is sensed. For example we may see wrinkles on our face and think, "Oh dear, I'm getting older". We only think that because decay is in our, unseen, **consciousness** and wrinkles only **appear, are seen**, for this reason. We have perceived life to be that way without an alternative. As the next scripture from the Old Testament states God does indeed give us "the fruit of our thoughts" now, this very second! He, the Omniscient All-Good in which "we live and move and have our being" (Act 17:28) gives us the **results of our thoughts**, not thousands of years ago but now.

[Jer 6:19 KJV] Hear, O earth: behold, I will bring evil upon this people, [even] **the fruit (result) of their thoughts**, because they have not hearkened unto my words, nor to my law (*vibration*), but rejected it.

Our senses, because they are so complex, so amazing, at the highest level work by way of our **perceptions**. If our perceptions are false then our senses follow on and give **false evidence**. Just to be sure on this point, our senses are wonderful and always in perfect working order; it's only our **perceptions** that **need to be corrected**.

[Psa 94:9 KJV] He that planted the ear, shall he not hear? he that formed the eye, shall he not see?

Now the awareness or Consciousness (the unseen) of Jesus Christ was **not of decay** but of the **All-Good** and as his **perceptions** were different, so his senses were different. What he sensed (saw, felt, smelled, heard, tasted) was the "evidence" from the knowledge of his True Identity, the Son of God. It was the "substance" of "faith" which is in the **unseen** being **evidenced** in the **seen**.

[Heb 11:1 KJV] Now **faith** is the **substance** of things hoped for, the **evidence** of things not seen.

Let's think of the many 'healings' Jesus made. He knew the sense of the false, collective body-consciousness of say the man in the synagogue, needed correcting. The man was 'seeing' his own hand ugly, withered and without any 'feeling', but the sense evidence (the seen) of the One,

True Consciousness that Jesus had, instantly gave the man a new hand which he could 'see' and 'feel', (Mat 12:10-13). How did he do it?

Jesus knew that the unseen, True Consciousness was always in evidence, just not 'seen' or sensed. When it is not in evidence it is veiled and said to be 'in darkness'. He corrected the situation.

[Mat 6:22-23 KJV] The light (*understanding*) of the body is the eye (*perception*): if therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light. 23 But if thine eye (*perception*) be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great [is] that darkness!

Jesus knowing the Truth, having the True Consciousness brought "Light into his body" which swallowed up the darkness that only veiled the perfect hand that was already there.

Heaven or Hell Consciousness

[Jhn 5:26, 27, 28, 29 KJV] For as the Father (*Consciousness of the All-Good, the **unseen***) hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son (*the **seen***) to have life in himself; and hath given him authority to execute **judgment (a deciding)** also, because he is the Son of man. Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall **hear his voice**, And shall come forth; they that have done (or *practise*) good (*thoughts from the One, True Consciousness*), unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done (or *practise*) evil (*thoughts from a false, collective body-consciousness*), unto the resurrection of damnation (*the misery of separation*).

These, previously scary, verses read in the old way of thinking (in collective body-consciousness) is probably where the idea of dying and going to either the **imagined places of heaven or hell** came from, which belief still persists to this day. But in the "hearing the voice of the Son of God" way of thinking, our One Consciousness knows that the "**judgement**" is an **individual's continual decision**, an acceptance of our True Identity which is "the resurrection of life". It means living a glorious life as a son of God without separation, a life of health and plenty, "glorifying God in your body and in your spirit" (1Cor 6:20), a **heaven**. The "they that have done evil" or those who practise a limited thinking from a collective body-consciousness, means experiencing a deadness of life in separation, which includes hardship, illness and decay, a **hell**. It's a "**perishing**" where Christmas continues to be an annual holiday instead of a one time **revelation** of the heart and mind.

This raising of our awareness is even alluded to in Psalm 1, when we have "ears to hear and eyes to see" -

[Psa 1:5-6 KJV] Therefore the **ungodly** (*ones who have body-consciousness*) shall not (*be able to*) stand in the **judgment** (*conscious decision*), nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous. For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous: but the way of the **ungodly** shall **perish**.

Jesus Christ is "equal unto the angels" in his Consciousness, so are we, as we are raised in awareness or understanding. We are resurrected to the "Son" status, where there is no death.

[Luk 20:36 KJV] Neither can they die any more: for they are equal unto the angels; and are the children of God, being the **children of the resurrection**.

When we have repented (turned from the back to front collective body-consciousness to the One Consciousness) and are resurrected we are no longer dead but "have the Son and have LIFE".

[1Jo 5:12 KJV] He that hath the Son hath life; [and] he that hath not the Son of God hath not life (*is dead*).

Finally God can dwell in and make His home in us as us; in our Consciousness and therefore our bodies; the way He always intended it to be.

[Rev 21:3-5 KJV] And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle (*dwelling place*) of God [is] with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, [and be] their God. And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be **no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.** And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, **I make all things new.** And he said unto me, Write: for these words are **true and faithful.**

We are united in "faith" having realised our True Identity as the "perfect man" in the status of the Son of God, the Christ. We are now **"children of the resurrection"**.

[Eph 4:13 KJV] Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:

[Eph 4:24 KJV] And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

The old collective body-consciousness is abandoned, replaced by the "new man", the One Consciousness of the All-Good, the "Son", the Consciousness of "LIFE".

Let's recap because there is so much confusion. The Apostle Paul's use of the words "flesh" and "Spirit" in the book of Romans may be helpful.

[Rom 8:9 KJV] But ye are **not** in the flesh (*you don't have a body-consciousness*), but (*are*) in the Spirit (*you have the One Consciousness*), if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you (*if you have resonated with the Son of God Consciousness*). Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ (*the Son of God Consciousness*), he is none of his.

The default state is the body-consciousness or the "flesh" as it says in Romans, in which the body decays and perishes. This consciousness can only be raised up (resurrected) by the Son of God Consciousness which is the "Spirit of Christ". Some may rise above their present consciousness without the "Spirit of Christ" but because of this their senses/body still decays and perishes; it is still corruptible.

[1Co 9:25 KJV] And every man that striveth for the mastery is temperate in all things. Now they [do it] to obtain a corruptible crown; but **we an incorruptible.**

[Jhn 1:11-13 KJV] He came unto his own (*sons and daughters of men*), and his own received him not. But as many as received him, to them **gave he power to become the sons of God**, [even] to them that believe on his name (*resonate with his Consciousness*): Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man (*born of the body-consciousness*), but of God (*are born of the Spirit*).

The Mirror Effect

The bottom line is that the **body** is a **reflection** of the **mind**. Whatever is in the mind, even at any one time, is **reflected on or in the body**.

[2Co 5:10 KJV] For we must all appear before the judgment seat (*make the decision*) of Christ (*the Son of God Consciousness*); that every one may receive the things [done] in [his] body, according to that he hath done (*decided*), whether [it be] good or bad.

The previous scripture has been taught in such a way as to imply that a judgement is made after the death of the body. THIS IS NOT THE CASE, EVEN THOUGH WE'VE GROWN UP THINKING IT WAS. It is a death of the **false** body-consciousness that is needed to enable one to "appear before the judgement seat of Christ", or else the body is in the default state of decay.

THE GOD MIND, the Son of God Consciousness evidences THE PERFECT BODY, but as stated before the **mind is like a mirror** and whatever is in that mind is reflected on that body. The man in the synagogue with the withered hand, had in his mind (body-consciousness) that he had a decaying, corruptible body, therefore he sinned, he "missed the mark" of the Son of God Consciousness. His withered hand was the reflection of his darkened mind that veiled his perfect hand.

The following Jeremiah scripture is a 'cf' under the title of 2 Corinthians chapter 3 within The Blue Letter Bible website. A 'cf' means in Latin to compare with, so I did compare the two and it backs up the now unveiled way of living. Instead of trying to obey the letter of the "law", the rules that Moses laid down (the old covenant) by good works, we obey by our perception because the "law" of vibration is "put in our inward parts (the new covenant)", which in this day and age we call our cells. It is the law that Jesus Christ fulfilled and that we share in.

Under the new "covenant" or New Testament we must align ourselves with the image of God, the incorruptible image of the Son of God; "the law of the Spirit of **life in Christ Jesus**" (Rom 8:2).

[Jer 31:33 KJV] But this [shall be] the **covenant** that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my **law** (*vibration*) in their **inward parts** (*cells*), and write it in their **hearts** (*subconscious*); and will be their God, and they shall be my people.

When the mind or consciousness is **veiled** it needs to be **unveiled by a new understanding**.

[2Co 3:18 ASV] But we all, with **unveiled** face (*consciousness*) beholding as in a **mirror** the glory of the Lord, are **transformed** into the same (*his*) image from glory to glory, even as from the Lord the Spirit.

The next scripture is from the Odes of Solomon which were lost for centuries and rediscovered in 1909. It echoes what Paul says in 2 Corinthians 3:18, (circa 55 - 57 AD).

From the Odes of Solomon - ODE 13 (circa 70-125 AD)

1 Behold! **the Lord is our mirror**: open the eyes (*perception*) and see them in Him: and learn the manner of your face: 2 And tell forth praise to His spirit: and wipe off the filth (*the missing the mark*) from your face: and love His holiness, and clothe yourselves therewith: 3 And be without stain (*without fault*) at all times before Him. Hallelujah.

The false body-consciousness dies (is crucified or crossed out) to be replaced by the Son of God Consciousness, Christ.

[Rom 6:11-12 KJV] Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be **dead indeed unto sin**, but **alive** unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord (*the Son of God Consciousness*). 12 Let not sin (*missing the mark*) therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts (*missing the mark desires*) thereof.

[1Co 15:52 KJV] In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump (*vibration - Strong's definition*): for the trumpet shall sound, and the **dead shall be raised incorruptible**, and we shall be changed.

When we have "put on Christ" we are not "male or female, but are all One in Christ Jesus", (Gal 3: 27, 28); the matrix out of which all arises, "Christ is all in all" (Col 3:11)
